Owners pay predictable monthly management and usage fees, while *Flexjet* manages aircraft maintenance, flight crews, hangars, fuel and insurance on their behalf. The *Flexjet 25* jet card program, operated by Jet Solutions, provides travel-by-the-hour on the *Flexjet 25* fleet of Bombardier aircraft. *Flexjet* fields an exclusive family of Bombardier business jets, including the *Learjet 40 XR*, *Learjet 45 XR*, *Learjet 60 XR*, *Challenger 300* and *Challenger 605* business jets.
