BOMBARDIER FLEXJET WAIVES FERRY FEES FOR ALL MEXICO DESTINATIONS WITH EXPANDED SECONDARY SERVICE AREA

- Destinations added in response to increased *Flexjet* owner travel to Mexico
- Repositioning fees waived for fractional owners of all aircraft and all share sizes

DALLAS, Texas, December 5, 2006 – *Bombardier Flexjet*, the fractional business jet ownership program of Bombardier Aerospace, has announced the expansion of its Secondary Service Area to include all of Mexico, giving *Flexjet* fractional aircraft owners the option of traveling to and from any location in Mexico without incurring ferry fees, or repositioning charges. *

“In 2005, *Bombardier Flexjet* was the first fractional jet ownership program to establish a Secondary Service Area waiving ferry fees to and from the Caribbean region and Bermuda for owners regardless of aircraft type and share size,” said *Flexjet* President Mike McQuay.

“With this expansion of our Secondary Service Area, *Flexjet* continues to demonstrate leadership in providing value and significant benefits for our owners,” he added. “This is the most expansive Secondary Service Area, with the fewest restrictions.”

According to Mr. McQuay, the decision to add all Mexican locations responds to a significant increase in travel to and from Mexico by *Flexjet* owners, both for business and leisure trips. *Flexjet* has noted double-digit increases year over year in travel to and from Mexico since 2003. Nearly 20 percent of current *Flexjet* owners now include Mexico in their travel plans at some point during the year, with Cabo San Lucas, Acapulco and Puerto Vallarta as the top leisure destinations and Mexico City as the number-one business destination.

“Mexico is an increasingly important business center for many of our fractional owners and an increasingly popular leisure destination. Now our fractional owners can take advantage of travel to and from any point in Mexico at a reduced cost.”
